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Chemical Peels Protocol

Pre-Application of Peel:

- Cleanse the skin thoroughly Remove grease and oils using 70% alcohol or acetone
- If desired, a plaster or Vaseline may be used to protect the eyes, nostrils and lips.

Don't proceed with peeling in case of any of following:

• Retin A Cream used for Acne. Should be discontinued 7 days before and after treatment

- Accutane: oral medicine for Acne. Absolute Contraindication
- Benzoyl Peroxide: cream for Acne.
- Pregnancy or lactating
- Open wounds, eczema, psoriasis, and contact dermatitis
- Client undergoing chemotherapy
- Waxing
- Fresh Tans
- Any red face
- Cold sores or Herpes simplex infection
- Tendency for Keloid Scars Formation

Applying the Peel:

- Always follow the sequence as outlined.
- Slightly overlap each area.
- Do not apply too thickly as skin may not be visible during application.
- Regularly use new gauze and cotton buds (for each treatment consistently use the same number).
- Follow the skin lines.
- Start timing the duration of the peel application from the moment you start applying it.

Recommended application duration for the first session is as follows: Anti Aging Peel (3 minutes), Anti Acne Peel (3 minutes), Lightning Depigmentat Peel (5 minutes) From second treatment session on, you can increase the application time by one minute (if the client was not satisfied by the skin reaction on previous session) up to a maximum of 7 minutes



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Order of application

- 1. The forehead (horizontal direction)
- **2.** The nose (vertical, semi- circular with cotton buds)
- 3. The cheeks (semi-circular, follow nasal/lip line to, and including jaw line)
- **4.** Below the eyes (horizontal with cotton buds maintaining a distance of 3mm under the lower eye lid)
- 5. The upper lip (horizontal/circular in combination with the chin)
- 6. The chin

Neutralization:

- After 3 to 7 minutes peelings should be actively neutralized using cold water.
- AHA peelings and salicylic acid peeling must be neutralized as soon as slight erythema occurs.
- The TCA peeling must be neutralized as soon as frosting takes place by using cold water shortly. Frosting will appear within 60 to 90 seconds! Neutraliser solution can be used for faster neutralizing of chemical peels.
- Keep Neutralizer at least one minute on the skin Thoroughly rinse the skin.
- To cool the skin even more you can use a Hyperboost Jelly face mask.
